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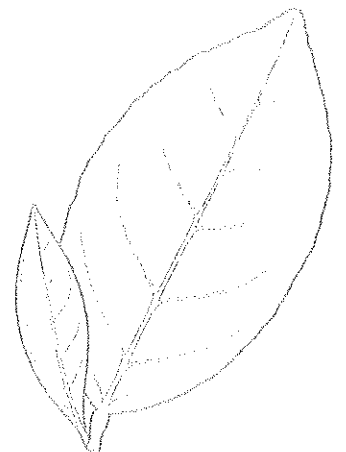

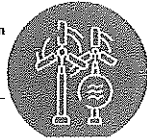

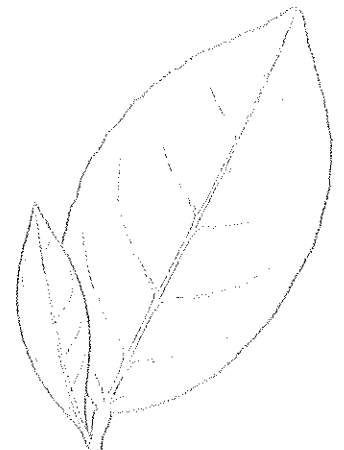

## Article 1 - Object of the Assignment, Place of Performance, Duration and Eligibility Requirements

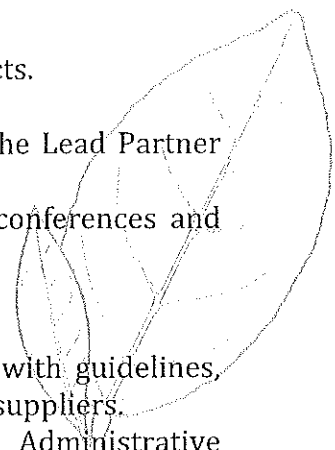

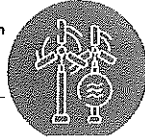
### Profile C – Communication Manager

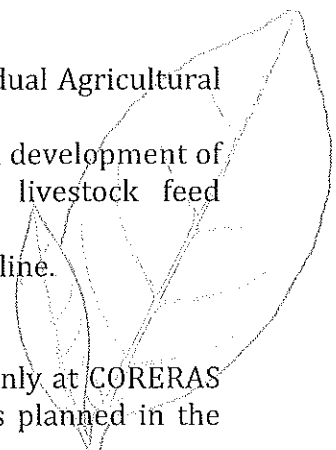

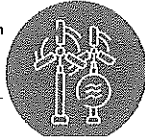

- At least two years of professional experience as consultant in projects and/or plans and/or programmes financed with EU, national or regional funds (e.g., RDP Sicily).

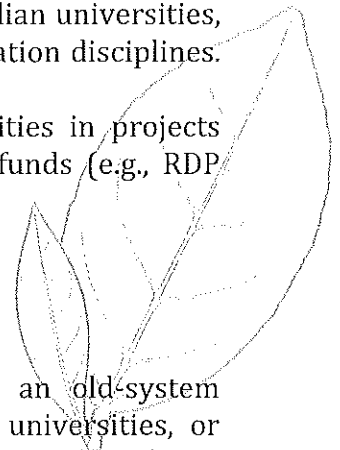

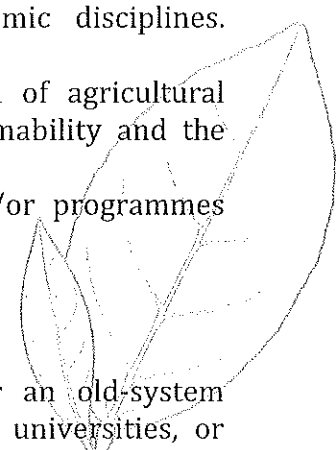

Profile G – Expert in Economics and Accounting for Financial Analyses

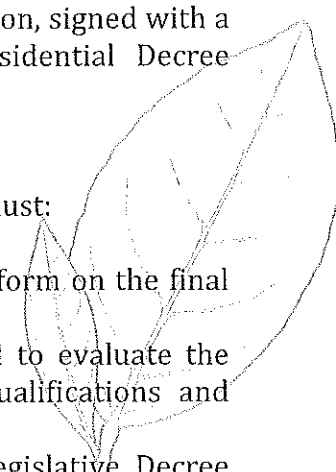
- Possession of a second-level degree (specialised/master's degree) or an old-system university degree (pre-Ministerial Decree 509/1999), obtained at Italian universities, or legally recognised equivalent qualification obtained abroad, in agricultural disciplines. Three-year degrees are excluded.
- Experience as laboratory technician for microbiological transformation of residual agricultural biomass.
- Professional experience in participation in projects and/or plans and/or programmes financed with EU, national or regional funds (e.g., RDP Sicily).
- Knowledge of English at least equivalent to B2 level.

## Article 2 - Application Procedures, Deadlines and Required Documentation

Only one application may be submitted for a single advertised position. In the case of legal persons (Profile D), company officers may not apply for other positions.

To be admitted to the selection procedure, applicants must submit, under penalty of exclusion, the following documentation inside an opaque envelope (properly sealed and countersigned across the flaps):

- duly completed application form providing all required data and information, signed with a handwritten (non-authenticated) signature pursuant to Art. 39 of Presidential Decree 445/2000, using the model "A" attached to this notice;
- self-assessment scoring sheet, using the model "B" attached;
- detailed curriculum vitae et studiorum bearing handwritten signature. It must:
  - be drafted in the European format;
  - be initialled on every page, numbered, dated, and fully signed in legible form on the final page;
  - include all information necessary to verify eligibility requirements and to evaluate the application according to the criteria set out in this notice, including qualifications and documented professional experience;
  - contain the authorisation for personal data processing pursuant to Legislative Decree 196/2003.





- d) an unsigned photocopy of a valid identity document (front/back), signed by the applicant. For legal persons, the document must belong to the legal representative;
- e) any documentation proving the possession of the specific requirements for admission to the selection;
- f) any documentation relating to additional titles that the applicant deems useful for evaluation purposes.

In Attachment "A", the applicant must self-certify, pursuant to Articles 38, 39, 46, 47 and 76 of Presidential Decree 445/2000, the possession of the minimum admission requirements listed in Article 2 of this notice.

Failure to provide the above documentation will result in exclusion.

Applicants must also declare — under penalty of exclusion — their consent to personal data processing pursuant to Legislative Decree 196/2003.

CORERAS may request verification documents at any time to confirm the validity and truthfulness of the declared requirements.

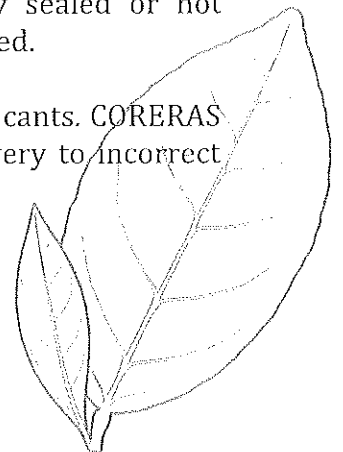

Applications submitted in transparent envelopes, envelopes not properly sealed or not countersigned across the flaps, or lacking the required wording will be excluded.

CORERAS accepts no responsibility for late delivery, third-party delivery errors, delivery to incorrect addresses, or any inaccuracies or disruptions attributable to the applicant. Any changes of address must be promptly communicated.

CORERAS declines any responsibility for:

- incorrect or illegible indication of the applicant's address;
- failure or delay in notifying address changes.





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Applicants may submit only ONE application referring to only ONE professional profile; otherwise, all applications will be deemed inadmissible.

This notice will be published on the CORERAS website [www.coreras.it](http://www.coreras.it) and on the Interreg NEXT MED Programme website.

CORERAS may, by reasoned Presidential Decision, exclude an application at any time for failure to meet the required eligibility criteria.

CORERAS reserves the right to extend, suspend, amend or cancel this procedure in accordance with applicable legislation.

### Article 3 - Selection Procedures and Evaluation Criteria

The evaluation of applications will be carried out by the Board of Directors of the Consortium and a representative of the Project Lead Partner.

The evaluators are subject to Article 35 of Legislative Decree 165/2001 and Article 7 of Presidential Decree 62/2013.

Those responsible for assessment must declare, pursuant to Article 47 of Presidential Decree 445/2000, the absence of any causes of incompatibility or grounds for abstention as provided for by the legislation mentioned above and by other applicable provisions.

A preliminary check will be carried out to verify the admissibility of applications by assessing:

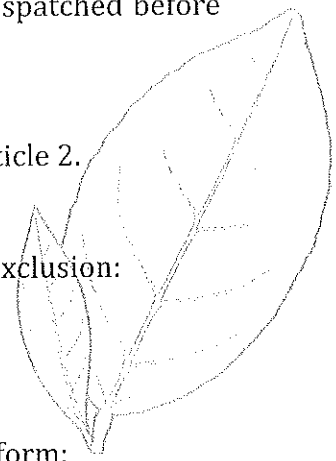
- compliance with the deadline and submission procedures stated in Article 2;
- possession of the eligibility requirements stated in Articles 1 and 2, as evidenced by the application form, the Curriculum Vitae et Studiorum, and any other submitted documents.

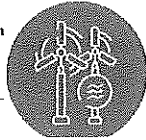
The following applications will be deemed inadmissible:

- envelopes received after the mandatory deadline set in Article 2, even if dispatched before the deadline (particularly those sent via post or authorised courier);
- envelopes received using methods other than those listed in Article 2;
- transparent envelopes or envelopes not delivered intact;
- envelopes lacking — even partially — the documentation required under Article 2.

The following circumstances cannot be remedied and constitute grounds for exclusion:

- 1) missing signature on the application form;
- 2) incomplete application form;
- 3) missing signature on the curriculum vitae et studiorum;
- 4) failure to submit the curriculum vitae et studiorum and/or the application form;
- 5) failure to submit a photocopy of a valid identity document (front/back) duly signed;





- 6) failure to authorise personal data processing under Legislative Decree 196/2003;
- 7) failure to meet even one of the eligibility requirements stated in Articles 1 and 2;
- 8) submission of a curriculum vitae et studiorum lacking the qualifications, skills, and professional experience necessary to verify eligibility.

No additions, replacements or modifications to the submitted application will be accepted if received after the mandatory deadline stated in Article 2.

The list of admissible and non-admissible applications will be published on the CORERAS website for two days.

For admissible applications, an assessment will be carried out to evaluate the qualifications, skills and professional experience as indicated in Article 4.

The Curriculum Vitae et Studiorum must include all data, information, time references and any other details required to enable an accurate evaluation of candidates and the allocation of points.

At the sole discretion of the evaluating body, qualifications, skills or experiences that are generic or lacking in essential details will not be considered for scoring purposes.

Only candidates who obtain a minimum score of 40 points will be admitted to the interview.

The schedule, including the date and location of interviews, will be published on the CORERAS website ([www.coreras.it](http://www.coreras.it)) two days before the interview.

This publication constitutes official notification for all legal purposes; no further communication will be provided, and candidates may not claim lack of notice.

Failure to attend the interview will be considered a full withdrawal from the procedure.

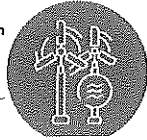
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## Article 5 - Formation and Publication of the Ranking List

At the end of the selection procedure, the evaluating body shall draw up, within 5 days, a merit ranking list indicating eligible candidates, non-eligible candidates, and excluded candidates, specifying the reason for each exclusion. The total score assigned to each candidate shall be the sum of the points obtained from the evaluation of qualifications and the interview.

Candidates who achieve a minimum overall score of 60/100 shall be considered eligible.

The merit ranking list prepared by the evaluating body shall be published on the CORERAS website [www.coreras.it](http://www.coreras.it).

The publication of the ranking list constitutes official notification for all legal purposes, with no further communication obligation on the part of CORERAS. Candidates are therefore required to consult the publication.

Appeals against the ranking list may be submitted within 5 days from publication.

In case of withdrawal or subsequent resignation of the selected candidate, CORERAS may draw from the ranking list according to the order of scores.

The ranking list will remain valid until 11/06/2028, and progression through the list may occur only in the event of refusal of the assignment by the first-ranked candidate or termination of the contract during the performance period.

## Article 6 - Assignment, Contractual Framework and Economic Treatment

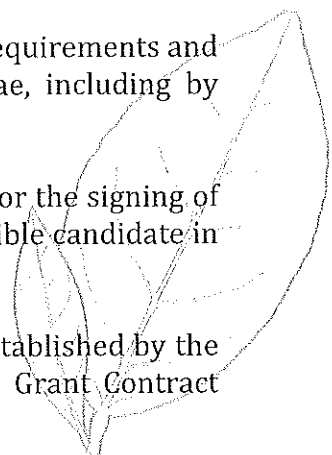
The selected candidate must declare their willingness to accept the assignment within 5 days from receipt of the communication.

They will then be required to submit the documentation necessary for the contract signature.

At this stage, CORERAS reserves the right to request documents proving the requirements and qualifications declared in the application and the attached curriculum vitae, including by sample checks.

Failure to provide evidence of the information declared, or failure to appear for the signing of the contract, shall be considered a full withdrawal. In such cases, the next eligible candidate in the ranking list will be appointed.

The contractual framework is bound by the rules, requirements and forms established by the programme guidelines applicable to the Lead Partner and Partners, by the Grant Contract signed between the parties (MA and LP), and by applicable legislation.





The contract will specify the obligations, duration, remuneration agreed upon by the parties, and any other provisions deemed necessary by CORERAS to ensure maximum quality and reliability of the services provided.

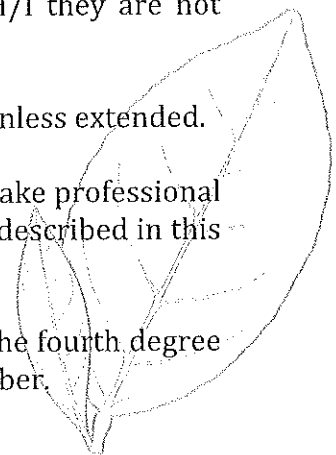
Travel, board and lodging expenses will be covered by the cooperation project and therefore considered extra-fee only for profiles A/B/C, while for profiles D/E/F/G/H/I they are not included.

The contract will start on the date of signature and will end on 11/06/2028, unless extended.

Under penalty of contract termination, the selected candidate may not undertake professional assignments in projects creating situations of incompatibility with the duties described in this Notice.

Contracts cannot be signed with spouses, relatives, or relatives-in-law up to the fourth degree of members of the Board responsible for selection, nor with the external member.

Contract termination clauses:





Pursuant to Article 1456 of the Civil Code, the contract shall be terminated if any of the following occur:

In such cases, CORERAS may terminate the contract without notice and without penalties, even in derogation from other applicable regulations.

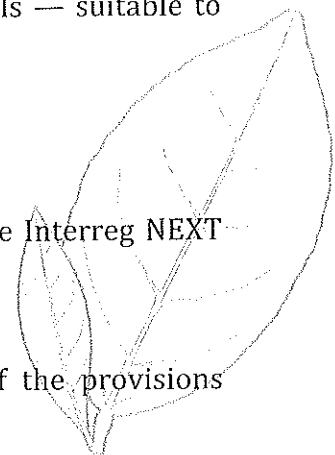

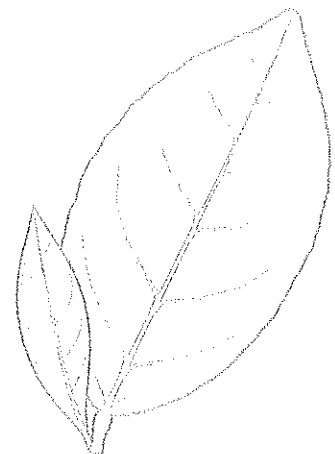
